Monthly Descriptive Report of programmes and activities organized at Nehru Science Centre, Mumbai and its Satellite Units for the month of October, 2024

NEHRU SCIENCE CENTRE, MUMBAI

- 1. National Wildlife Week: NSCM celebrated the National Wildlife Week during Oct 2-8, 2024 with Science Film Shows in collaboration with Goethe Institut. During the celebration, five science film shows were organized, which attracted 609 children. The event aimed to raise awareness of wildlife conservation and engage the youth in understanding the importance of biodiversity.
- 2. World Space Week: As part of World Space Week celebrations during Oct 4-10, 2024, visitors were offered guided tours of the Aviation & Space Gallery. An open house quiz was held on 05.10.2024 on the topic of Space & Astronomy, with enthusiastic participation from 348 attendees. An online quiz, also focusing on Space & Astronomy, was conducted on 06.10.2024 with 99 participants. The sky observation program was held on 06.10.2024, where 30 participants gathered to learn about telescopes and celestial objects.
- 3.Swachhata Hi Seva Campaign: Throughout the month of October, films on various scientific topics related to cleanliness and hygiene are being screened as part of the "Swachhata Hi Seva" initiative. This ongoing film show aims to promote public awareness of cleanliness and its significance. A slogan contest is being held (10.10.2024 - 31.10.2024) to inspire creative expressions on the theme of cleanliness. Slogans have been collected through a drop box. 53 Open House Quizzes were conducted on the theme of "Swachhata" (cleanliness), with 2135 participants engaging in the challenge. Prizes were distributed to the winners, promoting the importance of hygiene and clean surroundings. A nukkad natak based on the theme of "Waste Segregation" was staged by the education department from 26.10.204 to 31.10.2024. 65 students participated in the Painting contest held on 26.10.2024. A popular Science lecture titled "Waste management and Circular economy" was delivered by Dr A P Jayraman along with Science film on garment waste management was screened in collaboration with Goeth Institut. 255 students and general visitors attended the lecture. 31 students participated in the "Science from Scrap" workshop on 26.10.2024 and 86 participants enjoyed the Sky Observation session. Weeding of more than 300 files in Admin, Finance and Store sections and outdoor cleanliness drive in NSC campus have been carried out during this month.
- 4.MSE visits: Visits were conducted at Dnyanganga Primary Residency Marathi School in Parabhani on 03.10.2024, at Babasaheb Deshmukh High School in Banpuri on 09.10,2024, at Gandhi Prathamik & Madhyamik Shala in Parbhani on 10.10.2024, and at Scottish Academy CBSC School, Parbhani on 23.10.2024 as part of the Mobile Science Exhibition (MSE). The visits aimed to enhance scientific awareness among schoolchildren through interactive exhibits.
- 5.3rd IOAA-Jr 2024: India participated in the third International Olympiad on Astronomy and Astrophysics for Juniors (IOAA-Jr 2024) held in Kathmandu, Nepal during Oct 3 10, 2024. The 3 participants were selected among the 20 participants in the Orientation Cum Selection Camp (OCSC) held at Nehru Science Centre, Mumbai during May 2024. The Indian team, comprising three participants and two leaders, performed excellently. Mast. Sumant Gupta from New Sainik Sr. Sec. Public School, Noida, Uttar Pradesh, and Mast. Pranjal Dixit from Delhi Public School, Secunderabad, Telangana, secured gold medals, while Mast. Shashank Kaundilya from Central Public School, Samastipur, Bihar, won a silver medal.

- 6.**Experimental Skill Test** was held on 13.10.2024 in collaboration with BASE association involving six participants. This event focused on testing participants' practical skills in scientific experiments, furthering their understanding of experimental techniques.
- **7. Vigilance Awareness Week:** All the staff members of NSCM took the pledge on 28.10.2024 to observe the Vigilance Awareness week to promote integrity, transparency and accountability in governance on the theme "Culture of Integrity for Nation's Prosperity". Webinar on "Cyber Security Awareness Month: Cyber Security in the Era of AI and 24 hours Online platform" was conducted by Curator Sumit Chatterjee on 16.10.2024, attended by 42 participants. 367 people attended the online Webinar on "Securing our Online World" by Mr Amit K Ghosh on 25.10.2024 and 398 people attended the hybrid lecture titled "Unlocking Readiness Plan" by Mr. Sukrit Ghosh on 26.10.2024.
- 8. **Exhibit development:** A new exhibit on "A journey through time of an ancient grain: Millets" was developed and installed at the Science for Children Gallery. Several new exhibits were developed and installed as part of the renovation of Hall of Nuclear Power Gallery at NSCM, titled "Story of Atom", "Fission & Fusion", "Peep into Atom", "Classification of Reactors", "Moderation of neutrons", and "Principles of Heat Transfer".

Inter-school Annual Science Quiz & Valediction

Science Museum School Project

A special Sky Observation Programme for observing Moon, Venus, Saturn & comet Suchichan was organised for visitors on 14 & 15 October 2024 at RSCN. The programme received very good response from visitors and students. Around 93 people took an advantage of this unique opportunity.

Sky Observation Programme (outreach)

An outreach Sky Observation Programme was organised by Raman Science Centre & Planetarium, Nagpur at Balasaheb Thakre International Zoological Park, Gorewada, Nagpur for for the public on 19 October 2024. Around 235 visitors observed Venus, Saturn and Moon through telescopes arranged by the centre.

Swachhata Hi Seva Campaign

Swachhata hi Seva campaign was promoted by Raman Science Centre Nagpur by organising programmes for the staff, students and visitors. REGIONAL SCIENCE CENTRE, BHOPAL

As a part of the celebrations, programmes viz: Special Film Show on Space exploration, Special Stargazing with Telescope, Sunspot Observation with Safe Media, Special Taramandal Planetarium Camp, Demonstration of Water Rocket, Special Art & Craft Programme (Topic: Chandrayaan-4 Moon Sample Retriever Module) etc. were organised during the period among students and the general public. Around 110 participants participated in all these programmes.

Sci-Birthday

RSC, Bhopal organised 1 no of Sci-Birthday programmes on October 12, 2024. A total of 50 people participated in the programme. Technologies. A total of 12 schools were covered by each unit during the period. Apart from the Science Exhibition, Science Film shows and Science Demonstration Lectures are also being conducted at each site.

Additionally, on October 29, 2024 an open-house quiz was conducted for visitors, engaging them in discussions and questions on the significance of integrity and ethical practices for a prosperous nation.

14. Mobile Science Exhibition on "Hygiene and Sanitation"

The District Science Centre, Dharampur organized Mobile Science Exhibition on "Hygiene and Sanitation" during Swachhta Hi Seva 4.0 campaign from 01.10.2024 to 15.10.2024, which included 06 sites - of Valsad district, with Swachhta selfie point, Pledge on Swachhata providing them with valuable information and insights into cleanliness and sanitation. Followed by film show, Session on anti-superstition program to eradicate superstition from society. In total, 1757 students general visitors visited the MSE bus on sites.
